YOUTH CONNECT

Youth Connect (YC), is a program of Children's Community Mental Health Services and Wraparound Milwaukee. Youth Connect (YC) is a short-term, 60 to 90 days, intensive Crisis Care Coordination program that serves youth and families with a focus on preventing and responding to mental health crisis in an effort to reduce in-patient hospital stays. A Youth Connect Crisis Care Coordinator (YCCC) and Coach work with the youth and family to provide crisis planning and response, community connections to address factors which contribute to overwhelming stress that leads to crisis, and provide a bridge to enrollment in other Children, Youth and Family Services programs if appropriate.

Participation in the Youth Connect Program is 100% voluntary for those who are willing to seek support and meet the minimum eligibility requirements:

- A Youth living in Milwaukee County
- Youth up to the age of 23 years old
- Youth not already involved in another program or system, i.e. Wraparound SOC Programming, Child Welfare, Youth Justice, Disabilities Services, etc.

Youth Connect will assist with the following:

- Identify the needs goals and actions that will be addressed during enrollment
- Identify community-based supports that YC plans on connecting with the family.
- Identify Peer Support needs that will be addressed.
- Identify ways to address the barriers to accessing support: transportation, insurance status, wait time for appointments, communication assistance.
- Create a transition plan to the next point of assistance
- Include a warm handoff to that next resource.
